- **Lunch Program:** Mr. Smooth is our vendor, covers three schools; delivery around 11am; school staff will deliver to classrooms; will plan for back up in case prep location is closed due to weather etc.; trying to coordinate with schools plus for extra food to go to Cole Harbour kitchen so there is no waste food
- **Grade 3 Assessment Results (Literacy and Math) May 2024:** Reading – 89% meeting (above board); writing – 47.4% meeting (above board) (students have to have a pencil in their hand to 'write', mandate from province); math – 88.9% meeting expectations (above board)
- **Safety Systems -Technology Update**

- PA System – new! Different alarms for lockdown, bells etc.
- Door Access (Atlantic View Drive) – outdoor access pad, part of emergency management plan
- Cameras – outdoor cameras (4 or 5?), some are 360 degree cameras, one on oil tanks out back
- **Staffing update:** Need additional staff, EPA (80%) and resource (.5)
