Business arising from meeting summary:

- **Lunch Program**
 - Started in October.
 - Vendor is Mr. Smooth. Very good feedback. Good quality.
 - Apprx. 80 per day taking advantage of the program.

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- **Staffing Update**
 - 80% EPA and .5 resource teacher have both been hired to fill staffing vacancies.

School Improvement Plan Update:

- Nearly through cycle 1.
- Literacy
 - Students are writing at longer legnth. Looking forward to quality of writing vs quantity
- Math
 - Fact fluency has been the focus.
 - Working on effective and efficient strategies for problem solving
 - Many students are using the strategies taught and modelled.
- Well Being

- Talking about the size of a problem and how they are feeling. Identifying what needs to be done in order to be regulated. (self-regulation, asking for help, etc.)
- Talking about how different things affect different people
- Using common language to identify problems and their size

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New Business (current items):

- **Photographer Contract**
 - Going to reach out to Lifetouch, Photomaster, Rob Allen Photography
 - Going to ask companies to present to SAC February 20th 2025
- **Gravel: Parking lot and School Grounds**
 - Contractor coming December 5th to gravel (and level) parking lot, and gravel all mud areas in the school grounds including the back.
- **School Grants**
 - **Our 3 Grants will be coming in:**
 - SAC Grant \$5k + \$1 per student
 - Healthy Schools Grant \$5k + \$1 per student
 - To be used towards well being, physical activity, etc
 - Student Support Grant
 - \$5k + \$1 per student
 - Divided between classes for speakers, field trips, etc.
 - Paul Fields (parent) with ArtShine programming has been brought forward
 - Going to meet and get more information and options to be presented at a future SAC meeting
 - SAC is in favour of full-school programming to be funded by school.
- **SAC Fund**
 - Refreshing classroom libraries, \$500 per classroom
 - Used toward school supplies
 - Going to start a conversation about change in the area of the garden beds
