SUMMARY

Work undertaken with assistance from the grant to improve student well-being and success and how it supported the Student Success Plan (SSP):

The focus of the grant was to increase physical activity and cooperative play; and to support a culturally inclusive environment through the purchase of resources connected to student identity. Each class selected a variety of play resources for use during recess and lunch hour (balls, scoops/balls, hula hoops, etc.). Work was also done to bring our GaGa pit back in use for students. Materials representing Indigenous and students of African Descent were purchased for students and for their classrooms. (Books, Scribblers from Native Reflections, multicultural paper, markers/crayons, etc. as well as band aids that reflect different student skin tones). All students also received a 'Be Kind' Inclusive T-Shirt. This work was to directly impact students' sense of belonging and wellness at school (supporting our SSP Well Being Goal). ~~Add text~~

DETERMINING PRIORITIES

How the school engaged with students, teachers, the School Advisory Council (SAC), and other partners within the school community, to determine how to use grant funds:

Students had input into the resources purchased for outdoor play through a Google Form shared with their teacher. Through conversation with staff at PD and in staff meetings ideas were shared and priorities created relating to increasing our representation for cultural diversity within our school. Our SAC met on a monthly basis and were provided updates and contributed to our conversations providing a community lens. ~~Add text~~
