



Volunteering at Atlantic View



In accordance with HRCE's Student Protection Policy, prior to volunteering with the Halifax Regional Centre for Education, all volunteers will provide:

- 1. A completed Child Abuse Register Child Abuse Register Search
- A certified and true copy of a Criminal Records Check with Vulnerable Sector-Criminal Records Check with Vulnerable Sector Search

Child Abuse Register Search and Criminal Records Check must be issued within the three months preceding volunteering and updated every three years.

These forms do take several weeks to get processed so it is important to get them completed in a timely manner and prior to volunteering. If you are interested in supporting the school please contact the office.

A New Way for Families to Report Student Absences

One of our greatest priorities is ensuring all students arrive at school safely each day.

Parents/guardians of students who attend our school now have the option to report their child's absence in advance using a toll-free number, the PowerSchool Parent Portal or an app!

SchoolMessenger SafeArrival – an absence management system that improves student safety and makes it easy for families to inform their child's school if they will be away – powers all three of these options.
