# Registration for September 2023 - NEW ONLINE PROCESS



New registration is only required if you are new to HRCE or your child is beginning school in pre-primary or primary. Please note: Pre-primary children are not required to re-register for primary.

### What You Need to Begin

- 1. Verify your neighbourhood school. If the school you want your child to attend is outside of your neighbourhood, you must first register for your home school and then follow the process for out-of-area requests.
- 2. Before you begin, make sure you have the following documents in electronic form (image, PDF or Word Document).
  - Proof of identity/age with one of the following: birth certificate, passport, immigration papers, or legal adoption papers) if you are new to the HRCE;
  - Proof of home address (a recently dated official government or utility document with your current address that includes your name and date, such as water bill, power bill, internet bill, home fuel bill, a tax receipt, property assessment or a mortgage contract); and
  - Nova Scotia Health Card or Canadian Province Health Card or, for non-citizens while in Canada, proof of Medical Insurance Information.
